**Fire Hydrant Flushing** – Fire Hydrant flushing and inspections will take place July 18th and July 19th between the hours of 4:00 am and 7:00 am. When the hydrants are being flushed, the water may become cloudy or discolored. Run cold water for a few minutes and the cloudiness and discoloration will be cleared. Please try to refrain from washing white clothes during this time. Should you have any questions please feel free to contact Town Hall M-F 8:00 am – 5:00 pm at (302-349-4534).

**High Volume User Form** – Do not forget to turn in your High Volume User form, if you haven't already. This form is to be filled out for any of the reasons listed on the form. You will be charged for the water used, but you will receive a credit on your sewer charges, based on the average sewer charge that you have had in the past. Please return the completed form at your earliest convenience.

**Big Saturday** – The Big Saturday festivities will be held on Saturday September 7, 2013. Please see the Town's website for a vendor form. The Town's website is [greenwood.delaware.gov](http://greenwood.delaware.gov).

**Grass Ordinance** – The Town of Greenwood has a Grass Ordinance. With the start of summer please keep in mind to cut your grass when necessary. Anything in excess of 8 inches in height will cause you to receive a notice about cutting your grass. Then if it is not cut within the required time the Town will cut it and bill you for the cost.

**Cut Grass in the Street** – It is a violation per Ordinance **A3B** for any owner or tenant to permit grass clippings to be blown, swept or raked into the streets of the Town of Greenwood. This action is detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Town of Greenwood and if done will be considered a public nuisance. Failure to comply will result in the Town correcting the problem at your expense plus a \$250.00 administrative fee.

**Water Conservation Tips** – In an effort to help the residents of Greenwood conserve water we will be including a monthly water conservation tip. The tip for July – “Teach your children to turn off faucets tightly after each use.”
